

Presidential Greetings and Salutations...

Pesky RF in the Shack: Here recently, I have been plagued with RFI/EMI issues in the shack. Whenever I would fire up the 811H amp, my computer would start making that sound it makes when you plug in a USB device. Occasionally, it would just lock up like a brick, requiring a hard reboot. I have had the amp for almost 2 years, without any issues. It wasn't until I started running FT8 and had to use a multi-port USB extender to make up for the lack of USB ports on

my old, out-of-date laptop that the issue popped up. Crossing my fingers and hoping for an easy (and cheap) solution), I ordered some snap-on ferrite beads from HRO (MFJ-700C4). I was able to get at least three, and in some cases five, wraps of wire through the ferrite chokes. After installing them on every cable coming in and out of the laptop (see figure 1), I am happy to report



that the RFI/EMI issues have disappeared.

HF Remote Station Postponed: The HF remote station at the MSTF has been postponed. Taking into account the uncertainty surrounding eClub funding moving forward, the club voted unanimously at the last meeting to play it safe and abstain from spending the \$1,500 that was



up for approval. This doesn't mean that the project won't happen. But, it will be an item that the club can revisit at the beginning of 2021, after we have a better idea of the viability of the eClub, and how disbursements will be handled. To that end, I encourage people to spend the \$25, and join the eClub. Without our support, the eClub will go the way of the Dodo Bird.

2M AllStar Link: It may be a weeee bit more difficult to install an AllStar link on our 2m repeater than we originally anticipated. Don't fret, though –we are still looking at options and work-arounds, and plan to "adapt and overcome." Once we establish an AllStar link, our sphere of influence will expand dramatically. Soon, we will take over the World.

2m/70cm local link: If you have participated in the weekly 2m NET (Tuesday @ 11:45; 147.160 + PL100), you may have noticed there is a mysterious tone that can be heard from time to time. That is the link to our 70cm repeater (443.900 + PL100) timing out. We are currently working to resolve this issue. Of course, this, too, is proving to be a little more difficult than expected. It seems that we can't just set the egg timer to a longer duration and call it a day. Nope. We are having to disassemble the link, and send some equipment to Jim (W5ZIT) in Tucson for a bit of reprogramming. Aside from not having two locally linked repeaters for a month or so, there shouldn't be any noticeable interruption in service. Both repeaters will function as they normally would, just minus the link.

TxPOTA: Next month is the annual Texas State Parks on the Air. As is our tradition, MFARC has rented shelter #17 (with amenities –microwave, 'fridge, HVAC) at Cooper Lake South Sulphur Unit. The event is the 18th and 19th of April. I will be heading out on Friday the 17th to set up. All comers are welcome.

COVID-19 Precautions – Visitors to plant no longer allowed

With a cross-functional leadership team adjusting to information regarding COVID-19 virus, further restrictions have been put in place. The latest is the cancellation of attendance to trade shows, conferences or external events, such as School Recruiting. These restrictions will be in place through April 10th. Additionally, visitors to the L3Harris plant will no longer be allowed until further notice. Restrictions do not applied to badged contractors and service providers. However, visitor approval can be done through a Functional Vice President, along with a health self-assessment form prior to visit. Instead, job candidates and other visitors are encouraged to use Skype or other forms of video conferencing.

The move released today compounds other travel restrictions recently imposed to only include Business Critical Travel, which includes required customer visits to perform business, bids or other meetings that cannot be handled by electronics means.

We will continue to watch our personal hygiene and take steps to practice good habits now, in the event that COVID-19 makes a visit close to home.
